- Class 45 Novice Show Pony - Ridden** Open to ponies not exc.148cm, not to have won an open showing class.
- Class 46 Riding Club Horse / Pony Club Pony** Any height/type, rider any age. 2 min individual show & small jump.
- Class 47 Family Horse / Pony** Judged on individual show of versatility and usefulness, Ridden, may be assisted/led.
- Class 48 Best Rider** Any height/type horse/pony. Riders 14 years & under on 1st January 2019.

Showing Championship Exhibitors placed 1st or 2nd in classes 42 - 48

- Class 49** (not before 1pm) **Delightfully Dapper** Judged on turnout, presentation, presence. In-hand/ridden/led.
- Class 50 Prettiest Mare** Any height/type horse/pony. In-hand or ridden, may be assisted/led.
- Class 51 Handsomest Gelding** Any height/type horse/pony. In-hand or ridden, may be assisted/led.
- Class 52 Junior Handler** Judged on handler skills & turnout. Handlers 12 years & under on 1st January 2019.
- Class 53 Best Horse** Judged on way of going, manners and presentation. Ridden, may be assisted, not led.
- Class 54 Best Pony** Judged on way of going, manners and presentation. Ridden, may be assisted, not led.
- Class 55 Judges Choice** Judged on usefulness, character and appeal to the judge. Ridden, may be assisted/led.

**SHOW JUMPING - RING 3 (BS Club rules apply) - Starts 9.00am** **Entry fee: £10 per class**

- Class 56 Lead Rein Jumping** Open to ponies not exc. 148cm, and riders 12yrs & under on 1st January 2019. Judged on style and performance. Lead rein attached to noseband.
- Class 57 Super Mini Jumping 30cm** Open to ponies not exc. 148cm, and riders 14yrs & under on 1st January 2019. Mainly cross poles, no spreads. May be assisted in the ring, but not led.
- Class 58 Mini Jumping 40cm** Open to ponies not exc. 148cm, and riders 16yrs & under on 1st January 2019. Single or two-phase competition. May be assisted in the ring, but not led.
- Class 59 Minimus Jumping 50cm** Single-phase or two-phase competition with 2nd section against the clock.
- Class 60 Small Novice Jumping 60cm** Single-phase or two-phase competition with 2nd section against the clock.
- Class 61 Novice Jumping 70cm** Single-phase or two-phase competition with 2nd section against the clock.
- Class 62 Small Intermediate Jumping 75cm** Single or two-phase competition with 2nd section against clock.
- Class 63 Intermediate Jumping 80cm** Single-phase or two-phase competition with 2nd section against the clock.
- Class 64 Small Open Jumping 85cm** Single-phase or two-phase competition with 2nd section against the clock.
- Class 65 Open Jumping 90cm** Single-phase or two-phase competition with 2nd section against the clock.

WORKING HUNTER & WORKING HUNTER PONY - RING 4 - Starts 9:00am **Entry fee: £12 per class**

- Class 66 Training Stakes - Working Hunter Horse/Pony** Open to horses exc. 148cm and ponies not exc.153cm, judged on jumping & style plus overall showing impression. Jumps **A:** 60cm **B:** 70cm **C:** 80cm. Rider any age, can enter multiple sections.
- Class 67 Newcomer Working Hunter** Exc.148cm, not to have previously won any open WH class. Jumps 75-80cm.
- Class 68 Working Hunter** Open to horses exc.148cm. Jumps approx. 90cm.
- Class 69 Novice & Newcomer WHP** Not exc.153cm, not to have won any open WHP class. Jumps 60-65cm.
- Class 70 Working Hunter Pony A:** Ponies not exc.133cm. Jumps 70cm. **B:** Ponies exc.133cm but not 143cm. Jumps 75cm. **C:** Ponies exc.143cm but not 153cm. Jumps 85cm. Rider appropriate for height of pony.

- Class 72 Eventer's Challenge 70cm** Single phase competition with 2nd section against the clock. 1st section show jumps, 2nd section cross country style jumps.
- Class 73 Eventer's Challenge 80cm** Single phase competition with 2nd section against the clock. 1st section show jumps, 2nd section cross country style jumps.
- Class 74 Eventer's Challenge 90cm** Single phase competition with 2nd section against the clock. 1st section show jumps, 2nd section cross country style jumps.
